





Outcomes following emergency surgery for traumatic brain injury (TBI) – a multi-centre, international, prospective cohort study



Who can participate?

- ANY hospital performing emergency surgery for TBI worldwide can participate.
- Local teams consist of a minimum of 2 people. Any surgeon, physician, trainee or medical student is encouraged to participate!
- All team members will be indexed on PubMed as collaborators on all publications resulting from the study.



What does participating involve?

- Pick any 1-month period between 1st October 2018 and 1st April 2019.
- Register your site.
- Data should be collected on all patients receiving emergency surgery for traumatic brain injury during that time and followed up for 14 days or when they are discharged, whichever comes first.
